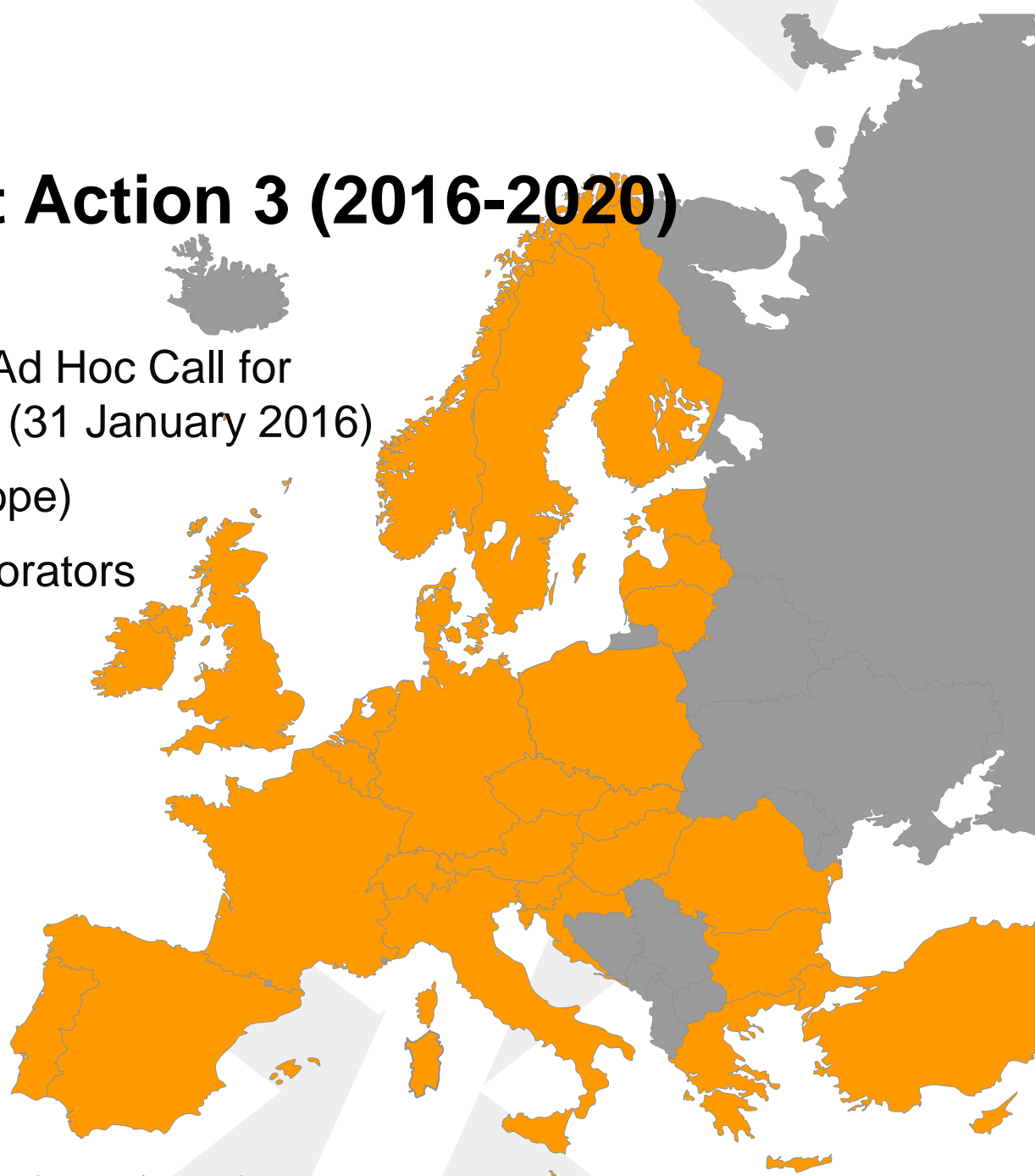

# EUnetHTA Joint Action 3 (2016-2020)

- Health Programme Ad Hoc Call for invited beneficiaries (31 January 2016)
- 75 partners (all Europe)
- More than 40 collaborators
- 20 million €



# ¿Qué es la Evaluación de Tecnologías Sanitarias?

- Es un proceso científico de producción de información sobre el impacto **médico, social, económico y ético** relacionado con el uso de la tecnología sanitaria.
- Tecnología Sanitaria: Es el resultado de aplicar el conocimiento científico a la actividad sanitaria. Incluye medicamentos, dispositivos, procedimientos quirúrgicos, programas, sistemas organizativos
- La ETES pretende asesorar en la toma de decisiones en política de prestaciones sanitarias, de tal forma que se optimice la **seguridad y efectividad al menor coste**

# EUnetHTA Project (2006-2008)

## Objectives

- To establish an effective and sustainable European network for Health Technology Assessment – EUnetHTA – that informs policy decisions
- To reduce overlap and duplication of effort and hence promote more effective use of resources
- To increase HTA input to decision-making in Member States and the EU and hence to increase the impact of HTA
- To strengthen the link between HTA and health care policy making
- To support countries with limited experience with HTA

# EUnetHTA Joint Action 3 (2016-2020)

## Objectives

- **To develop a strategy and proposal for a scientific and technical mechanism of permanent sustainable European Collaboration on HTA in the light of the Directive on CBHC**
- To increase the use, quality and efficiency of joint HTA work at European level to support evidence-based, sustainable and equitable choices in healthcare and ensure re-use in regional and national HTA reports and activities, in order to avoid duplication of assessments
- To contribute to the dissemination of health information and knowledge, thus improving policy-and decision-making in the health systems, which turns into protection of citizens against unsafe or ineffective technologies and improves access to high value health technologies
